JUNO LIGHTING GROUP™ ***Changing Lighting Forever***

Juno Lighting, Inc. was founded in 1976 with the vision of offering high-quality lighting fixtures that are attractive, well-engineered and easy to install. Today, under the Juno Lighting Group™ umbrella, the company comprises nine product brands, making it a single source lighting manufacturer for commercial, retail, industrial and residential applications in North America. The product category brands are: Juno®, Indy™, Alfa, AccuLite™, ModuLight®, Aculux™, NaviLite®, DanaLite and Elate™. The following describes all nine brands of Juno Lighting Group:

Juno®: Recessed and Track Lighting

Juno, the company's first product line, continues to offer distinctive, high-quality recessed and track lighting that is easy to install. Juno Lighting is regarded as the market leader in the track lighting category. Juno's products – which are used in retail stores, hotels and restaurants, residences and commercial buildings – include Trac-Master® and Trac 12 lighting systems, award-winning MH2, CMH downlights, and undercabinet lighting.

Juno's first track lighting line, the Trac-Master lighting system, represented a significant departure from "track lighting" as first introduced in the United States in the 1960s. Juno's design streamlined installation with breakthrough features such as a sliding latch adapter, which allows one-hand installation; a one-piece live-end cover; a floating electrical feed; and a convertible straight/corner connector. The system became widely recognized as the easiest to install and the lighting industry's most reliable track system.

Since then, Juno has continued to innovate by creating many new products that have since become industry standards – from the first energy-efficient IC Down-Lites to the first installer-friendly, affordably priced low-voltage flexible rail track system, known as the Flex 12™, and the Track 12/25 low-voltage track lighting system that allows more fixtures per line of track. Today, Juno continues its tradition of quality and innovation.

Indy™ : Architectural Recessed Lighting

Indy, acquired in 1988, is a leader in specification-grade downlighting and track lighting products used in commercial, institutional and retail applications such as hotels, casinos, department stores and specialty retailers. Working with architects, engineers and lighting designers, Indy provides innovative lighting solutions for its customers. And, Indy's in-house design and technical service team designs products and conducts comprehensive testing services to meet industry standards. The Indy product line includes incandescent, low voltage, compact fluorescent and High Intensity Discharge (HID) downlighting.

Alfa: Decorative Lighting Systems

Alfa, acquired in 2002, produces a full line of low-voltage cable and rail track systems along with a large assortment of elegant, decorative pendant and wall lighting fixtures in natural stone, colorful glass and metal finishes. Alfa's strong product offering is designed for illuminating spaces and objects that require a greater level of design and flexibility. Alfa is most often used for task and decorative lighting applications in retail stores, restaurants, hotels, office buildings, automobile showrooms and residences. The systems are often selected for their sleek designs and easy functionality. Alfa offers exclusive designs and finishes, including the award winning Tuscan Villa series pendants and martini sconce.

AccuLite™ : Commercial and Industrial Lighting

The **AccuLite** brand offers high-performance, energy-saving High Intensity Discharge (HID), fluorescent and incandescent lighting products for commercial and industrial applications. Juno acquired the product line in 2001.

AccuLite offers indoor lighting products including high- and low-bay luminaires, which are designed to illuminate large spaces such as commercial buildings, retail and grocery stores, factories, warehouses, distribution centers and indoor sports arenas. AccuLite also offers outdoor lighting products to provide security and illumination lighting for building facades, parking garages and parking lots. Outdoor lighting products include area, flood, building and canopy-mount luminaires. These products feature high-quality construction and superior photometric performance to lower installation and operating costs.

ModuLight®: Innovative Fluorescent Lighting System

ModuLight, introduced in 2004, is an innovative commercial lighting installation system. This power delivery and lighting system provides an easy-to-design wiring plan and is safer to install and maintain compared to a traditional wiring system. It also features a remote power converter, which takes the complexity out of reconfiguration and relocation. Key markets for ModuLight are commercial buildings, offices, schools, health care institutions and retail stores. The product line also includes emergency lighting systems. Aculux features a comprehensive series of high-performance, architectural-grade recessed luminaires. Aculux precision recessed lighting is perfect for residential applications where high performance and inconspicuous appearance are required. Aculux offers the smallest aperture available in the precision recessed market and the reflectors feature deep lamp shielding to eliminate glare.
